**Sub.: Invitation for ‘Conference on Cognition, Hearing

- e. Cognition and speech processing,
- f. Cognition and language processing,
- g. Cognitive assessment.
- h. Role of cognition in rehabilitation of individuals with communication disorders.

A structured abstract briefly describing objectives, methodology, major results and its implications, not exceed 500 words (excluding references), can be submitted in the Microsoft word format, not later than **10/02/2019**. The notification of the accepted abstracts will be made

by 15/02/2019, and full-length paper may be submitted by 25/02/2019. All accepted research papers are proposed to be published in the conference proceedings.
