The scientific committee of the Conference on Community-Based Rehabilitation invites abstracts to be considered for oral and poster presentations (offline). The abstracts of original research work may be submitted under the areas of Speech, Language, Hearing, Dysphagia/ swallowing, Psychology, Special education, occupation therapy and Medical social work. The submission is open to students (undergraduate and above) and professionals. **Those who want to compete for awards should submit a full-length paper.** The full-length paper submission date will be intimated later.

Abstract submission guidelines

Preparation of Abstract

1. Abstracts of original clinical/research work or case reports carried out by the authors are sought. Systematic review alone or compiling of work done by others/review of literature will not be considered.
2. First page:
 - a. Title of the original article/ case report, Authors, affiliation, designation and email id.
 - b. Specify the area under which the submission is made: speech, language, hearing, dysphagia/ swallowing, psychology, or special education. Mention the corresponding author's name and email address.
3. Main page:
 - a. Title of the original article/case report without details of authors
 - b. The abstract must be structured with the following sections: Introduction, Need for the study, Aim & Objectives, Method, Results & Discussion, and Conclusion.
 - c. The abstract should not exceed 500 words.
4. The abstract must have $\leq 25\%$ similarity with other published works.

Submission

- a. All abstracts should be submitted through scientificcommittee@jssish.in OR Web-portal cbr.jssish.com (Coming soon)
- b. The last date for submission of abstracts is November 20th
- c. Results will be announced on November 25th

Decision

- a. The committee will review the abstracts.
- b. The corresponding author will be intimated about the abstract selection by email.
