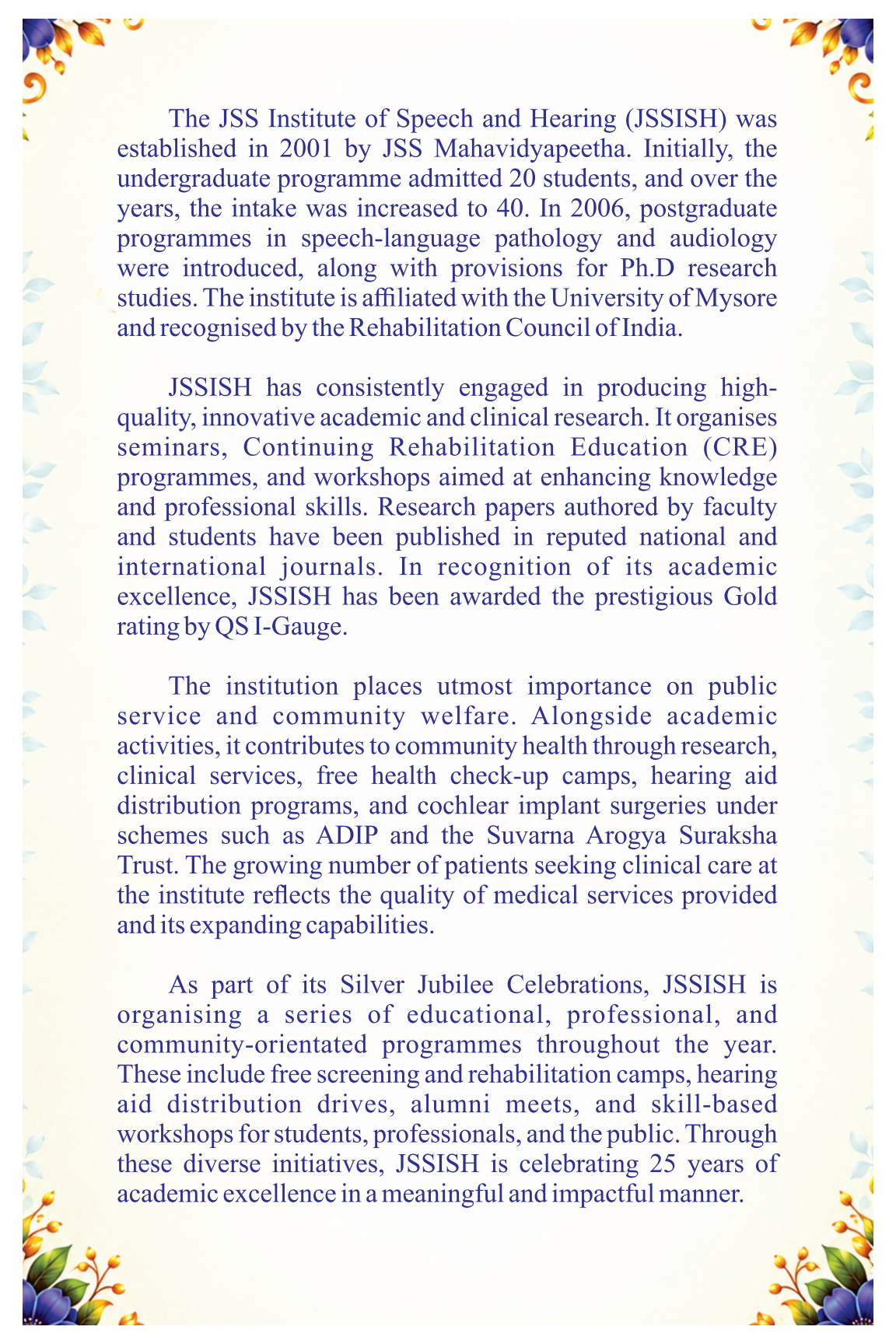

The JSS Institute of Speech and Hearing (JSSISH) was established in 2001 by JSS Mahavidyapeetha. Initially, the undergraduate programme admitted 20 students, and over the years, the intake was increased to 40. In 2006, postgraduate programmes in speech-language pathology and audiology were introduced, along with provisions for Ph.D research studies. The institute is affiliated with the University of Mysore and recognised by the Rehabilitation Council of India.

JSSISH has consistently engaged in producing high-quality, innovative academic and clinical research. It organises seminars, Continuing Rehabilitation Education (CRE) programmes, and workshops aimed at enhancing knowledge and professional skills.
